

Applications are now open for Arts Midwest's new grant program, [Cultural Sustainability: Equity-Based Operating Grants](#). This pilot program offers grants to small Midwestern arts and culture organizations that are rooted in communities of color.

1. **What is it?** Cultural Sustainability: Equity-Based Operating Grants is a general operating grant pilot program that offers grants of up to \$67,000.
2. **Who can apply?** Arts and cultural organizations rooted in communities of color with annual operating expenses up to \$500,000. Nonprofit organizations, fiscally sponsored organizations, and federally recognized tribes can all apply for this grant.
3. **Where?** Your organization must be located and operate within Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota, Wisconsin, or the Native Nations that share this geography.
4. **When to apply?** Applications close at 11:59 pm CST on October 15, 2024. Grants will be made in January 2025.
